### REFUGEE & IMMIGRATION SERVICES

### CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES

Provides stability and safety to children who have been abused and/or neglected by placing them in caring foster and adoptive homes. Inspiritus strengthens families to prevent abuse and neglect and aid in reunification.



### DISABILITY SERVICES

Helps individuals with intellectual disabilities obtain the support they need to live full, meaningful lives and thrive in their communities.



### DISASTER RESPONSE

Assists in the long-term recovery of areas afflicted by natural disasters and equips volunteers and congregations to respond to disasters and participate in recovery efforts.

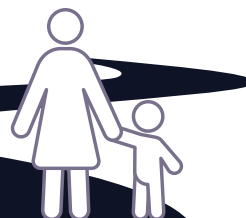
# SURVIVING TO THRIVING.
